






Jechieli is fascinated by this gadget and so Billy decides to give it to him as a gift which makes Jechieli very grateful and happy.


They continue talking and exchanging ideas while Asket and Billy go off in another direction towards the meadows chatting and enjoying a most glorious Mother Nature.
