These important contents were transmitted to Billy firstly through Semjase and later through her father Ptaah.

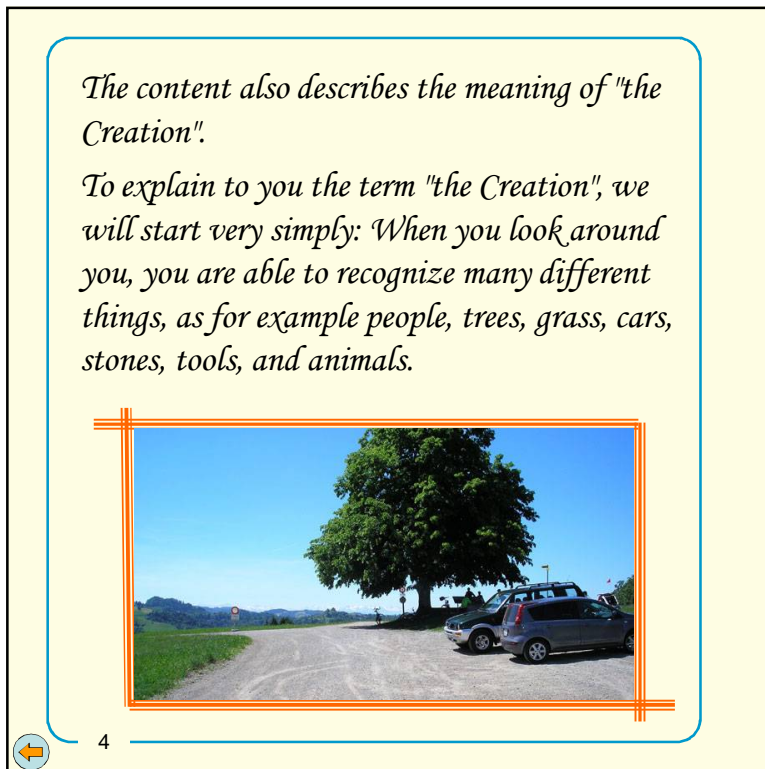
The content of the conversations deals with the “spiritual teaching” as well as a great amount of very important information about all reaches of life.

The Creation is the whole universe.



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The Creation is the power that gives us life, and which makes us living life forms in the first place.

In a simplified way "the Creation" may be called "nature", and we know that nature is alive, that it works and functions according to certain rules and laws. One of the laws which is easy to experience is the law of gravity. In your daily life something may have dropped out of your hand onto the ground or you have fallen down yourself. There is a force that pulls us towards the ground and keeps us there or keeps us walking upright. Without it, we and the atmosphere etc. would all be flying into open space and there would be no life on earth.

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Gravity is only one law of many that are present in nature and which were created by the Creation in order to function and operate as such.



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The older you grow, the more laws you will experience and notice in your daily life. These laws of the Creation also include the behaviour of people towards people, or from people to animals or plants and also the behaviour of people towards the Creation itself.

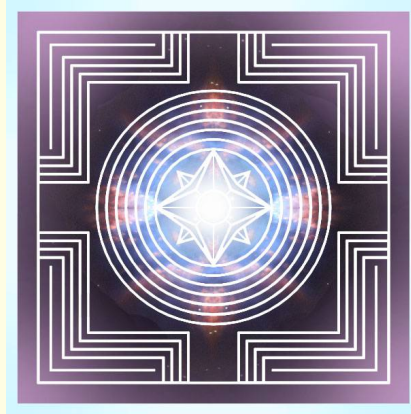
We will now further develop this first very simple explanation with basic knowledge. It will be explained to you again with different words:

The Creation is an impersonal, inexhaustible power and energy that gives us life that created the Earth, the stars and all galaxies, and still continues to create them.

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The Creation also makes it possible that we have – besides our consciousness – a conscience that gives us a hint if we are doing something wrong.



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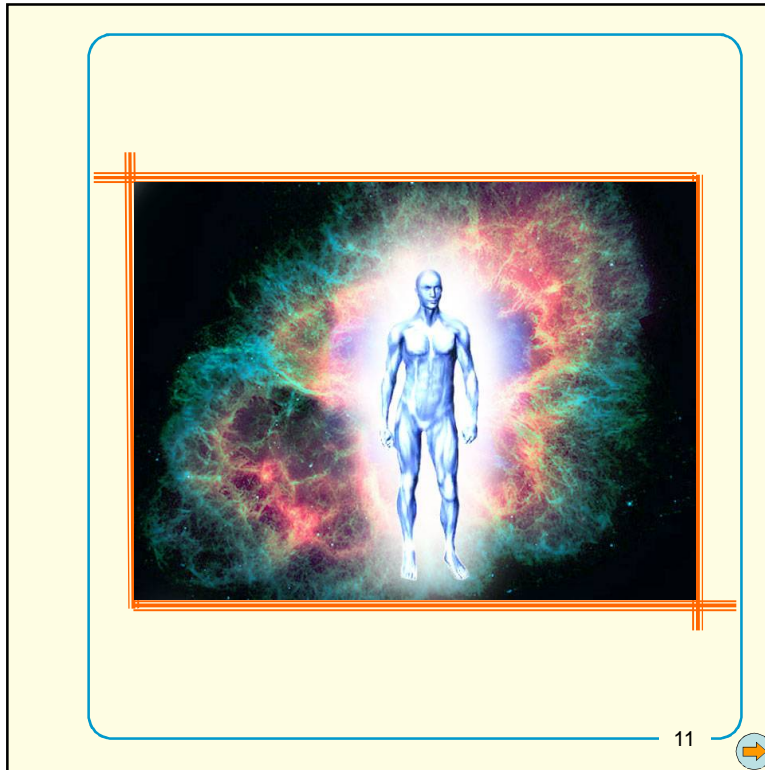
It is the power that makes all life forms – e.g. humans, animals, plants – living and viable in the first place, because a tiny part of the Creation itself exists in all of us, namely our spirit-form.

We, i.e. all human beings, animals and plants, live within the Creation and are part of it and it's laws, which can be experienced and seen in nature every single day.

The laws of the Creation make sure that there is order and that everything has it's place. These laws are called the "creational-natural laws".

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The word “creational” means that the origin of the laws is the Creation and that they contribute to the fulfillment of the laws of nature. Through them it is made possible that the planets, as well as all life itself, can develop at all and be “created”.



The word “natural” means that the laws are present all the time and are influencing our lives, even when we are not interested in them or if we ignore them. Gravity, for example, exists irrespective of whether one likes it or not, just as when a person stumbles and falls to the ground: either he likes it or not.

Even if some people claim that the world and nature are “chaotic” – it is not true. This alleged “chaotic state” is created mainly by human beings themselves, because they ignore the laws of nature and very often act contrary to the “creational-natural” laws.

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*Here another principle plays a central role:
The law of cause and effect.*

So it is the human beings who perpetrate actions which are directed against the creational-natural regulations and move themselves away from the creational-given



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framework of equilibrium and balance, harmony and freedom. This leads to the aforementioned actions, which bring and cause disadvantages to the human beings. As for example a fight between people may arise, or we pollute the environment, which in turn makes us sick,



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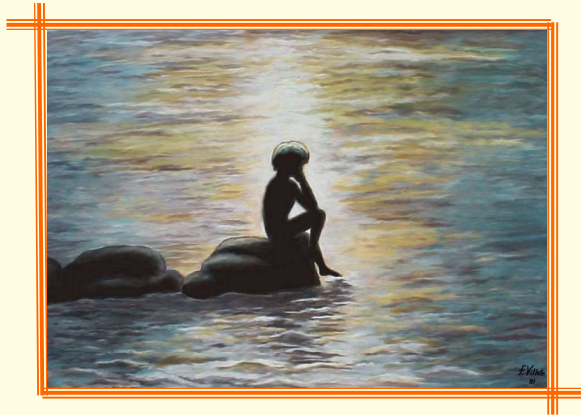
To prevent all this, we should not try to work against or contrary to the “creational-natural” laws, but act according to them. Whether or not a human being wishes to work with and towards the fulfillment of these laws, is his very own decision. Everything is dependent on the human being's own responsibility. The Creation does not interfere at all and is completely neutral towards all of its creations, including the human beings. All the bad and evil things a human being does, is only created by the human being himself and by nothing else.

This is the reason why the human being should always live each day in a well-considered way.

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He should always think about what he wants to say or do, and contemplate what he wants to achieve in his life, in order to be able to fulfill his responsibility, which everyone has to bear himself.

more harmonious, happier and more fulfilled.*



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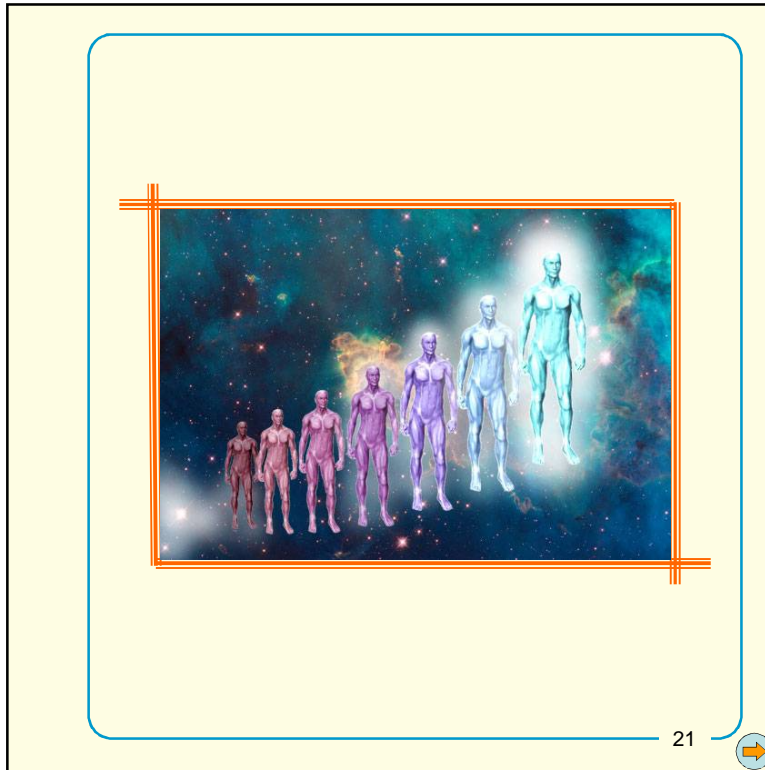


*The human being is the highest creation in
